

Length 2.1.n – CSV Export

Length Nesting version 2.1.8 and later adds an option to export the nested results to a CSV file which can be opened in Excel or similar spreadsheets. The CSV can also be used in third party applications.

The menu selection File | Export to CSV File is used to create the CSV file from a nested list. When selected, you will be prompted to select a folder and file for the exported data. If an existing file is chosen, the exported data will be appended to the end of the file. If a new file name is entered, the file will be created with the exported data.

If the nested list uses imperial dimensions (decimal or fractions), the values in the exported file will be decimal inches. If the nested list used metric dimensions, the values in the exported file will be in millimeters.

The first row in the CSV file will be a header row. The layout of the CSV file will be similar to a printed nested list. The columns in the file will be:

Description
Cut From Quantity
Cut From Length
Cut Quantity
Cut Length
Yield Quantity
Yield Length
Piece ID
Drop Length
Sq. Allowance
Kerf Allowance

If all of a 'to cut' item is not included in the nested results, those items will be listed at the end of the nesting patterns with 'Not Cut' in the Cut From column.
